



In the second session, Divyajyoti Sharma delivered an informative talk on 'Language of Advertising in Electronic Media' on how advertisements are used to convince potential customers about the qualities, benefits, etc. of a product, service, employment, etc. He also described both radio and television as powerful mediums of advertising and commented that radio is an audio medium and the language here should be complete and accurately understood by the ear while television advertisements contain both audio and video, here language should be simple and acting make it more interesting.
