Naharkatiya College at a glance

Naharkatiya College, Naharkatia in the district of Dibrugarh, Assam was established on 2nd August, 1964. Eminent Scholar and Literator Pandit Ram Prasad Chaliha was its founder Principal. From its modest inception as an Arts College, Naharkatiya College has now developed into its present status of a full-fledged degree college imparting higher education in Arts and Commerce stream. It is affiliated to the Dibrugarh University and registered under 2(F) and 12(B) of the University Grant Commission Act, 1956. The college has the distinction of being assessed and accredited twice by the NAAC and was placed in Grade B in a four point scale. The college has celebrated its Golden Jubilee in the year 2015 with a yearlong and continuous program. The college has developed its unique philosophy and vision, mission and programs of action.

The College had a humble beginning in the year 1997 at Charju, Khonsa before being shifted to its present location. Historically, it has a record in pioneering higher education in patkai region of Arunachal Pradesh and fulfills the long cherished desire of the people of this area. The college has been renamed from the earlier "Tirap Government College" to existing "Wangcha RajKumar Government College" by the Government in memory of late Wangcha Rajkumar, a renowned public leader; former Lok sabha M.P and AICC member (vide GO No.ED/HE/1291/08 dated 12th June 2008). It is situated about 10 minutes walk from the main town of Deomali, a sub-division of Tirap District. The college has, of course, expanded and changed over the last many years but it has always maintained its principle to provide an institution for imparting value based education. At present the college is imparting higher education degree courses of Arts and Commerce. It is affiliated to the Rajiv Gandhi University, Rono Hills Doimukh, Itanagar and registered under 2(F) and 12(B) of the University Grant Commission Act, 1956. The institution is committed to providing the leadership and direction for the times ahead in every sphere of human enterprise and endeavor and aims to establish symbolic cord between the teachers and the taught and endeavors to instill the concept of Vasudhaivautumbkam (the entire earth as one family).

Objectives of co-operation

The objectives of this memorandum of understanding (MOU) are to cooperate in educational, cultural and socialspheres in areas of mutual interest more specifically.

- 1. To promote and enhance academic interest between Naharkatiya College and Wangcha Rajkumar Government College, Deomali.
- 2. To provide an atmosphere of sharing expertise and knowledge among the students and the facilities between the two institutions.

<u>Article – 2</u>

Areas of Collaboration

Naharkatiya College and Wangcha Rakumar Government College hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through faculty exchange in furtherance of the advancement of teaching and learning as stated below:

- 1. To encourage visits by faculties from one college to the other for the purpose of teaching.
- 2. To encourage visits of students from one college to the other for the purpose of learning and cultural exchange.
- 3. To encourage the sharing of information and electronic resources.
- 4. To foster collaboration in organizing academic seminars, workshops, cultural programme, sports events etc.
- 5. To promote other activities which enhance the above mentioned goals.

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<u>Article – 3</u>

Coordinators

Both parties will designate persons who have responsibility for coordination and implementation of this agreement.

Article - 4

Rights

Both parties will honour their individual rights in performing their day to day academic activities. The collaborative activities under this agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis without deferring the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) of both the parties.

Article – 5

Scope of Cooperation

The both parties agree to cooperate programs including the following


- I. Exchange of best practices.
- II. Faculty and Student exchange programme.
- III. Skill based certificate course
- IV. Cultural exchange programme and sports events.
- V. Other areas as mutually agreed upon by the parties.

<u>Article – 6</u>

Area of Activities

- I. The parties agree to implement the programs stated in Article- 2
- II. Any changes of the location of the programs shall be mutually agreed upon by the parties.

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Any Ecoperation under the MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval of the relevant authorities.

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Any Specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement including II. financial and program specific arrangement.

<u>Article – 8</u> Confidentiality

In the event that one party wishes to disclose any data or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of the MOU, disclosing party shall have prior written consent from the other party.

<u>Article – 9</u> Limitation of Activities

The parties shall ensure that their personnel engagement of the activities under this MOU shall engage only in activities under the framework of this MOU with respect to national law and regulation.

Article -10 **Settlement of Disputes**

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the parties.

Article – 11 Amendment

- This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the i) parties and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
- Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined ii) by the parties.

<u>Article – 12</u> Duration

This memorandum of understanding will be for five years from signing date and year of MOU. Academic activities will be for five years i.e. from 2022 to 2027.


